Bill went to the 2013 Soil Symposium to be held in Bristol to receive our award. It's the annual get together where organic farmers and academics from round the world get together to learn more about soil science and the importance of managing the soils we grow in. This year's event was hosted by Monty Don.

There were many great sessions looking at; the ability of compost enriched soils to increase plant's resistance diseases. Using green manure crops to increase the nutrient and organic matter content of soils instead of fertilisers as part of sustainable land management.

There was also a presentation by a soil pathologist who uses traces of soil found on clothes, cars and objects to produce evidence against criminals. ... amazing levels of technology and definitely the last time we bury a body! you won't get away with it.
